WORKING DECOY - TRADITIONAL CLASS

The intent of this division is to judge decorative carvings. The carvings will be judged based on the following:

1. Entries will be limited to two (2) carvings per contestant.
2. Carvings must be hand made of wood or cork. No machine birds.
3. Carvings must be done by contestant and been started after February 26, 2011
4. Decoys will be floated and must self right when place in tank upside down.
5. All species of marsh & diving ducks will be acceptable & judged in open competition.
6. Primaries can be raised to capture essence of bird. (Shown below)
7. Must be hand painted and will be judged at a distance. (No airbrushing allowed).
8. All entries must be registered and in building by 11:00 a.m. Saturday, February 25, 2012.
9. Judging will begin at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, February 26, 2012.
10. Combing, stippling, brushing, ragging, scratching on cork burning permitted.
11. All carvings must be life size.
